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After breakfast aboard, we'll set sail for Orak Island, a paradise of crystal-clear waters perfect for swimming, paddleboarding, or snorkeling. Once you've had your fill of the sea, we'll cruise to Cökertme, a picturesque fishing village surrounded by lush hills. Here, you can relax in its tranguil bay or head ashore to dine at a local seafood restaurant. This family-owned gem produces exquisite wines and olive oil, and you'll have the chance to tour the vineyards, sample their finest offerings, and learn about their production techniques. It's a lovely way to immerse yourself in the region's culture and bring home a bottle (or two!) of their handcrafted wines or olive oil. Back onboard, dinner will feature the freshest catch of the day, and we'll anchor overnight in the peaceful waters of Çökertme-or perhaps closer to Karnas, depending on your preference.




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Today, we'll head to the Seven Islands region, a stunning archipelago brimming with hidden coves and pristine bays. Spend the day exploring these untouched gems, swimming in turquoise waters, and soaking up the serenity. Later, we'll cruise to Kufre Bay, where you can relax with water toys or join the crew for a guided fishing excursion if you're feeling adventurous. As the sun sets, enjoy cocktails on deck with views of pine-covered hills before sitting down to a themed dinner. We'll spend the night in the sheltered Uzun Liman (Long Port).





Here, you'll tour the family-owned vineyard, sample their exquisite wines and olive oils, and learn about their production techniques. Back onboard, dinner will feature wine pairings from Karnas Vineyard, making for a truly memorable evening. We'll anchor overnight in Karacasogut.




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We'll start the day with a cruise to Kisebuku (also known as Alakisla), where you can explore Byzantine ruins and enjoy some swimming and water activities before lunch onboard. In the afternoon, we'll head to Gumusluk, one of Turkey's most charming fishing villages. Here's where things get extra special—if you'd like, we can invite a local chef aboard for a private cooking lesson. She'll guide you through the art of Turkish home cooking, sharing tips and techniques to create authentic dishes that you can recreate long after your holiday ends. You'll have the chance to prepare—and then savour—a meal infused with the flavours of the region, perhaps paired with local wines for an added touch of indulgence.




