Day 1

Day 1 (Saturday): Trogir to Brač (Milna) Your cruise will start in Trogir, also called the little brother of Split. The tiny picturesque Trogir is more compact and offers as much history and culture as its big brother. After your check-in, you will sail to Brač. Brač is most known for its outstanding long, pebbly beach called Zlatni Rat (Golden Cape). However, on this cruise, you will head to the pretty fishing village of Milna - called "The Bay of 1000 Ships" by the Venetians - located on the northwest side of Brač. You will set anchor in its calm harbor and enjoy a delicious dinner onboard

Day 2 (Sunday): Vis Island – Komiža Vis Island is most well-known for its natural wonders – the Blue Cave and the Green Cave. Choose to spend your day exploring Vis or Komiža. • Jelsa


