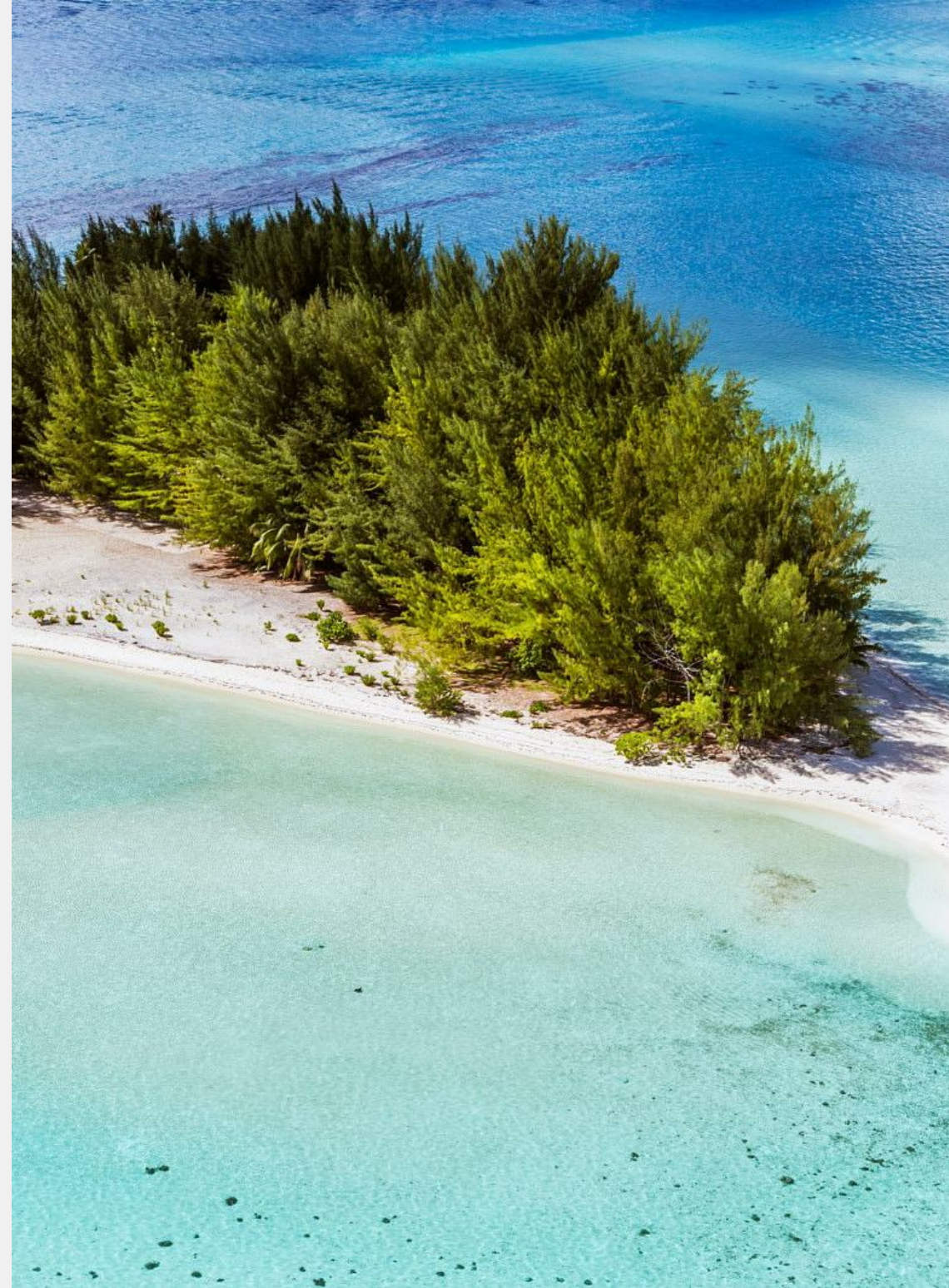
Day 1

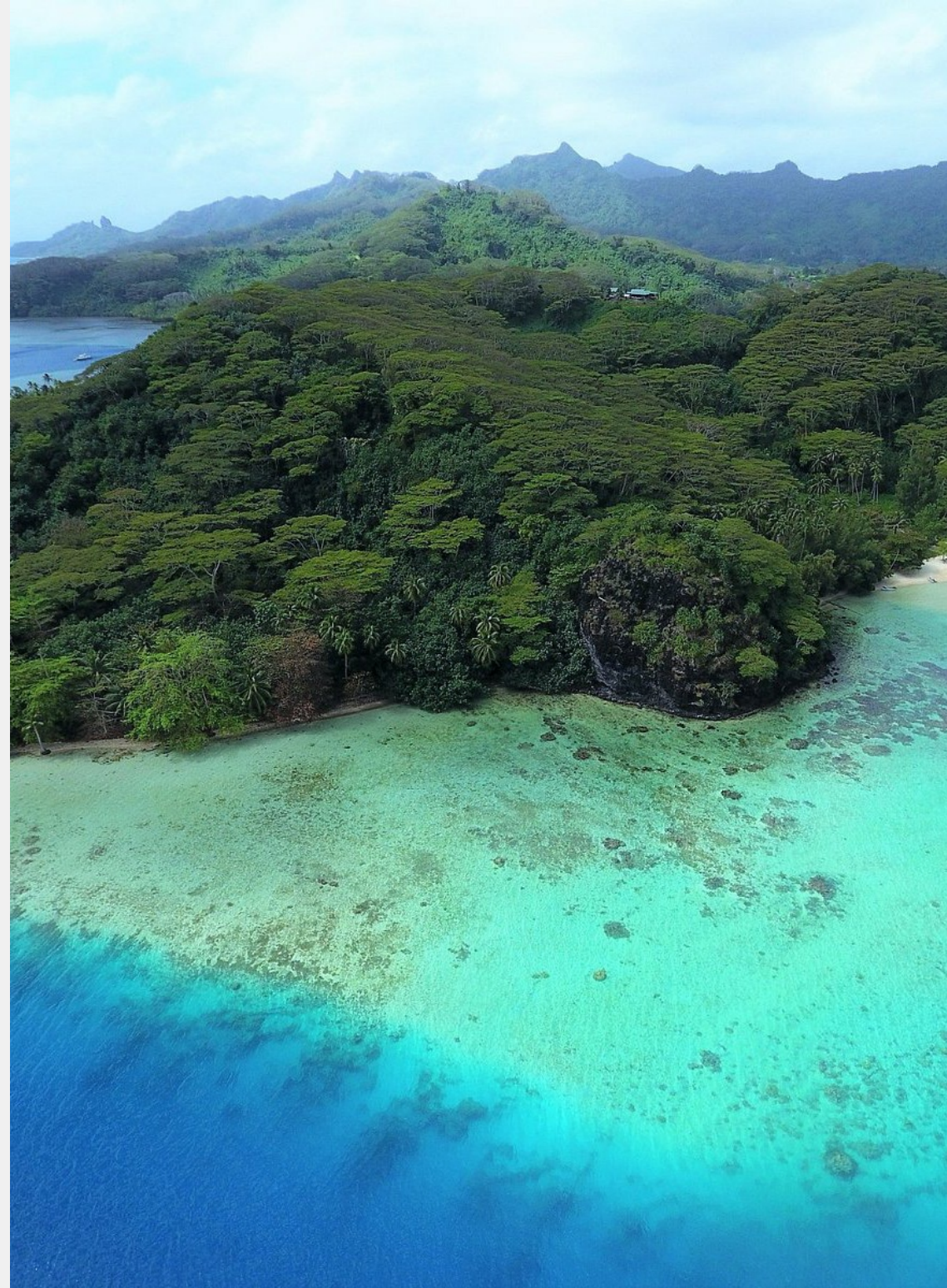
Day 5
