Day 3

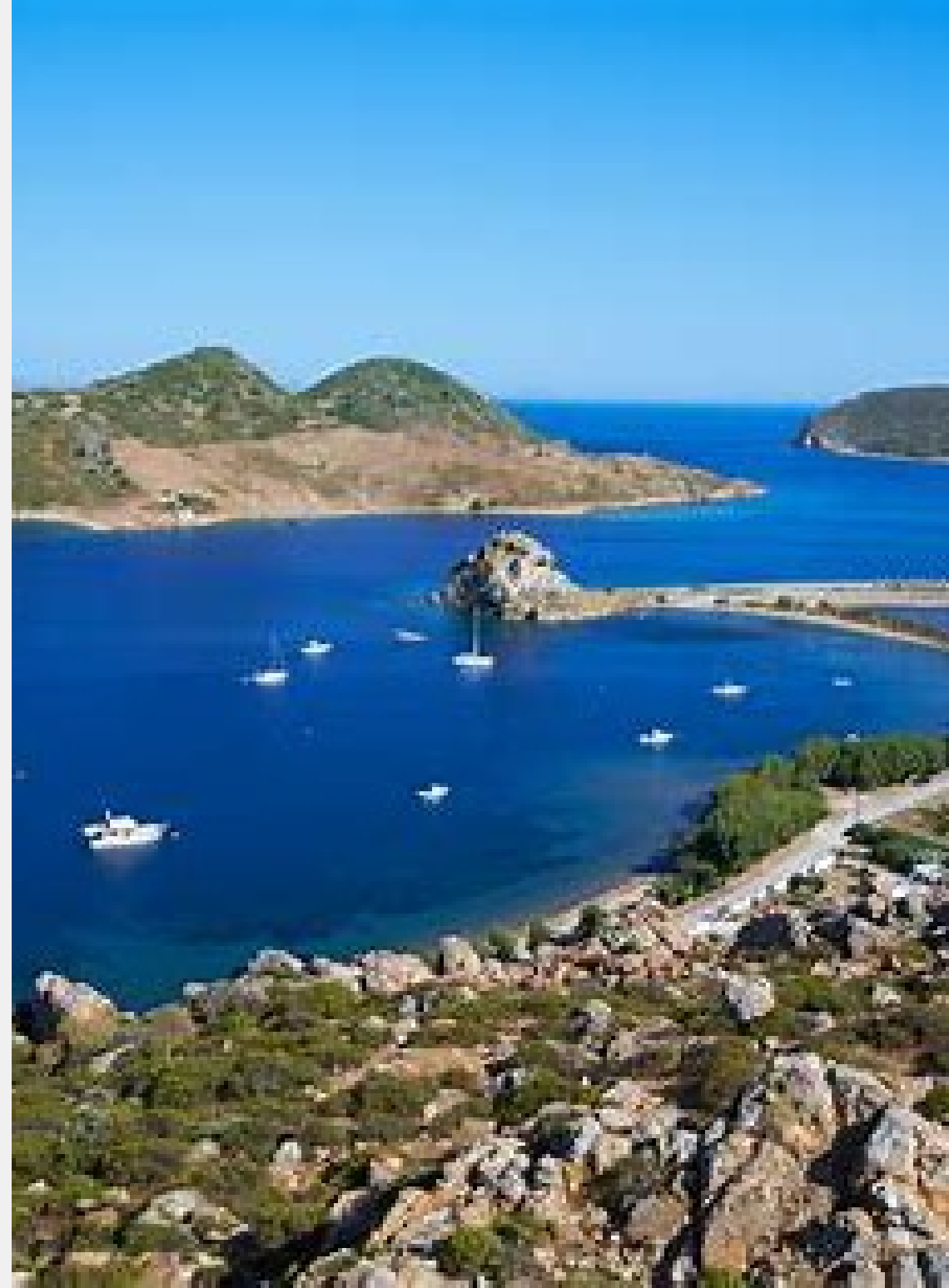
