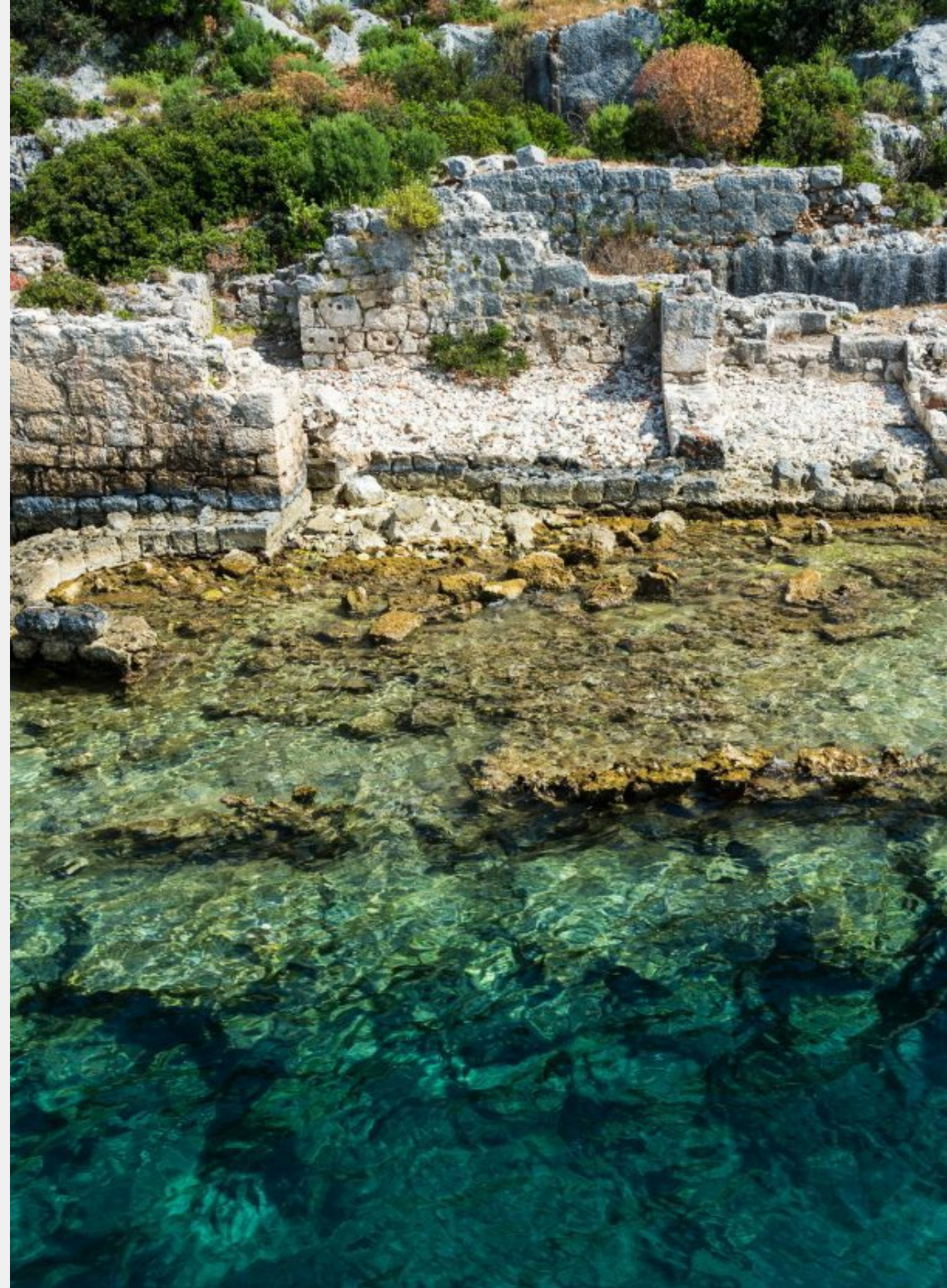
Day 3
