Day 2

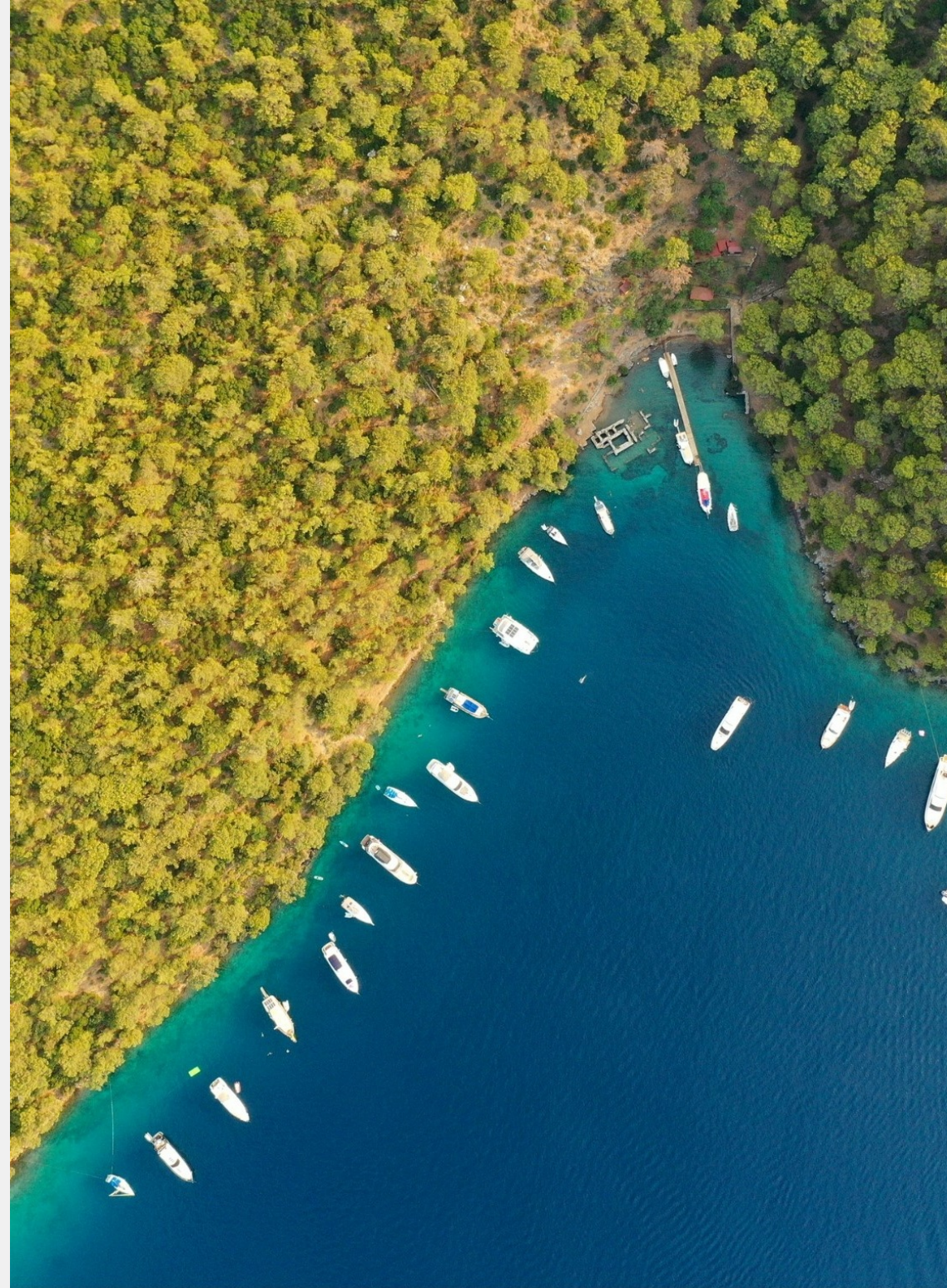

Day 3

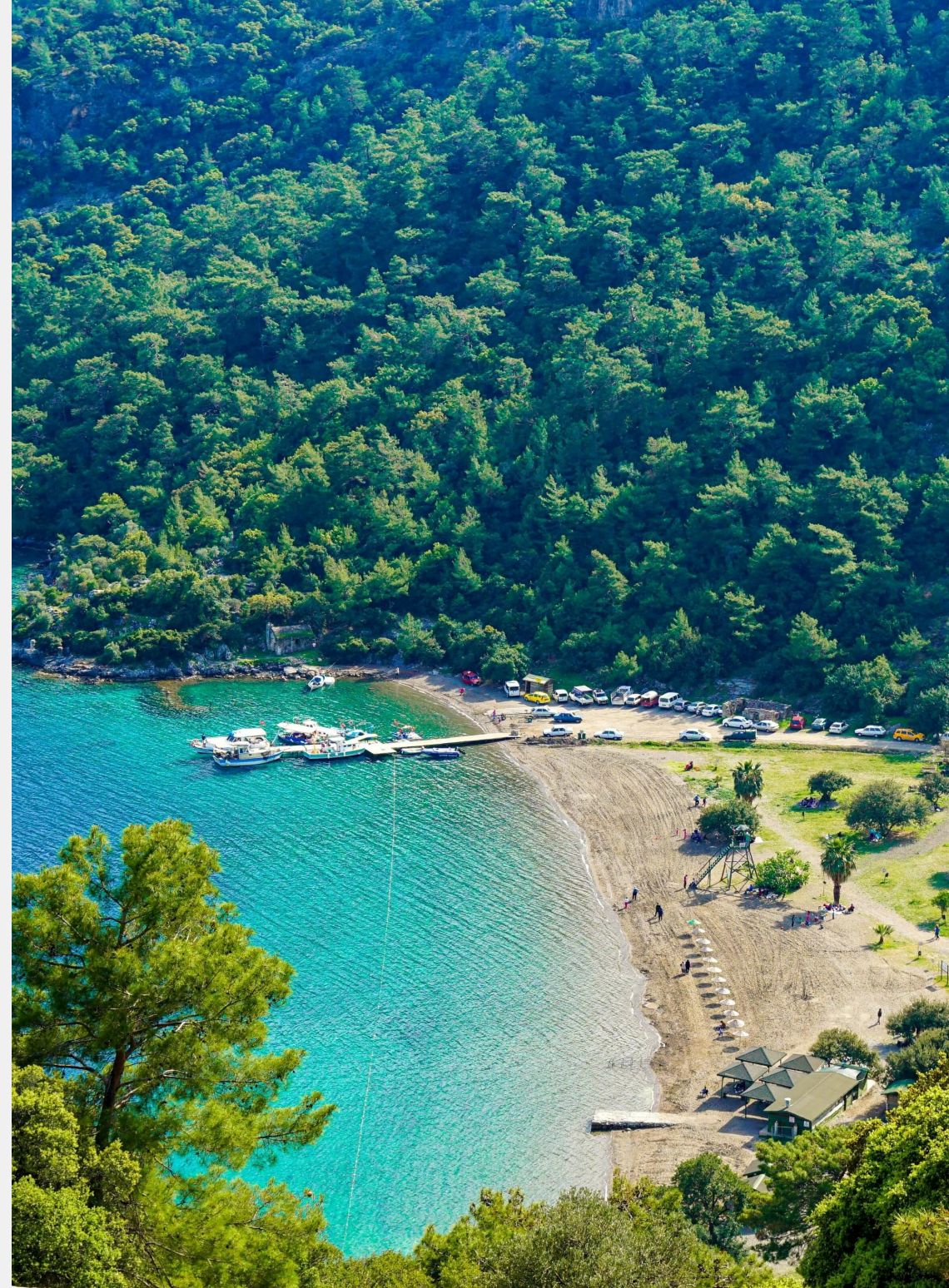
